2020: €24.2 billion, or 37% of total financing for climate action

Green financing, which involves climate action and environmental sustainability (**CA&ES**), was €26 billion, or 40% of total activity

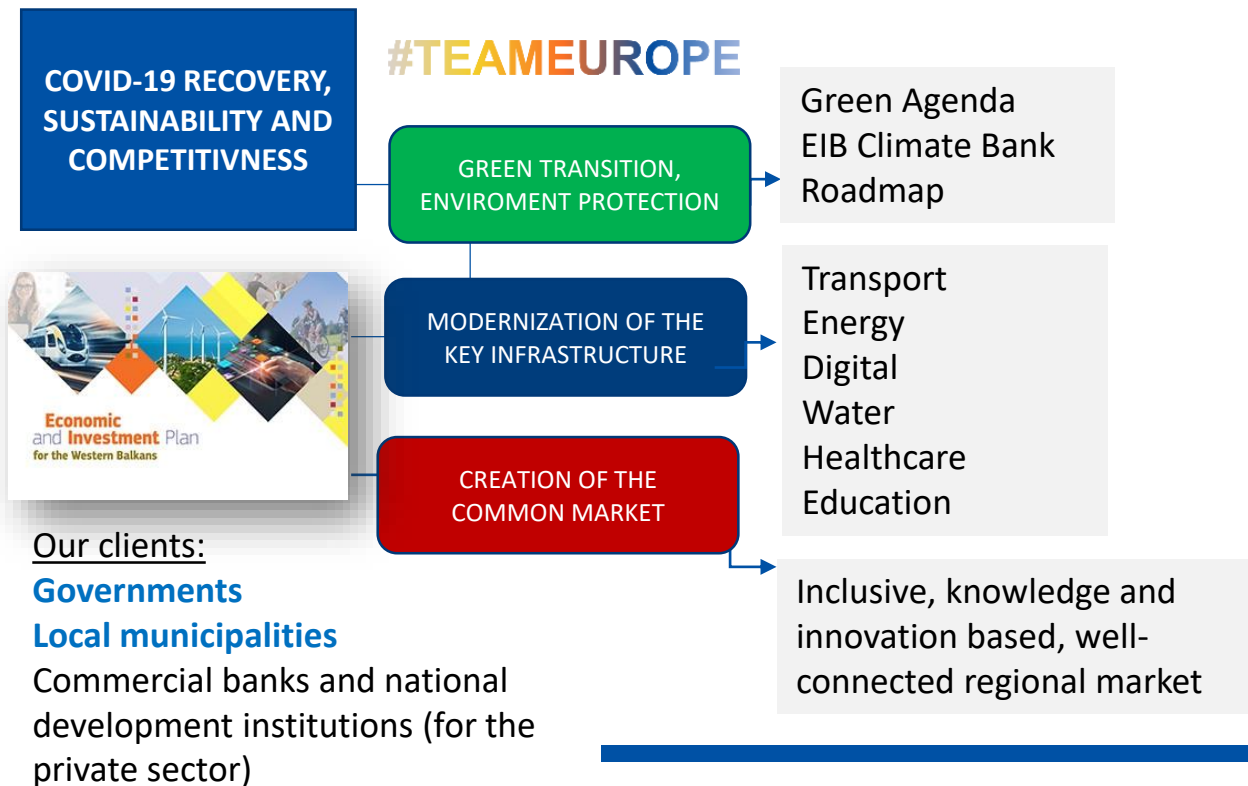
The EIB Group supports hundreds of thousands of small and medium-size firms, with an increasing focus on climate and environmental sustainability

The EIB is to sign the first SME loan for support energy efficiency and climate action among Montenegrin companies



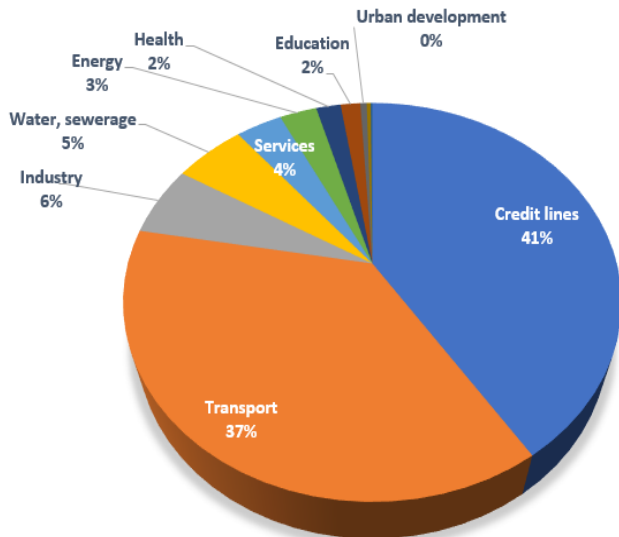
